

# COVID-19 Regulations for BLYC

*(Effective 05/01/2020 until rescinded or amended)*

BLYC COVID-19 Regulations are based on current NJ State Executive Orders, which at this time, mandates all social clubs to be closed.

Indoor Facilities, including clubhouse, bathrooms, storage facilities and kitchen are closed and are not to be accessed by any member or guest. (Exceptions allowed for essential club personnel with a need to access facility.)

Access to Outdoor Grounds is available only to Slip Owners, Dry Dock Storage Owners and essential club personnel as follows:

1. No loitering, socializing, gathering or congregating permitted (eg. Docks, Patio or Porch)
2. Slip Owners and Dry Dock Owners who wish to access their boats and Essential Club Personnel and club officers who have a need to access grounds or docks will follow current CDC guidelines, which are changing frequently, specifically:
  - a. Wear a surgical or N95 mask or homemade face covering while on property at all times

  - b. Do NOT come on the property if you are sick

  - c. Practice strict Social Distancing (stay minimum of 6' from other people)
  - d. Practice CDC hygiene guidelines, i.e., hand washing and/or hand sanitizer use
3. Slips and dry dock storage will be open to members under contract
  - a. Outdoor water spigots are turned on
  - b. Electricity will be on for outside outlets and timer activated dock lights are operational
  - c. Owners will avoid congregation around land stored vessels
  - d. Hoists may be operational
4. Access to vessels is allowed as follows:
  - a. Only the immediate household of active BLYC members currently cohabitating with the owner of the vessel – BLYC

member – are permitted on the property with the specific purpose of boarding the member's vessel

- b. Guests for family members of any BLYC Member who are not part of that household are not permitted on the property for any purpose including boarding and disembarking from member's vessel
  - c. No club privileges are being extended to other sailors or non-BLYC vessels at this time
  - d. Social distancing between vessel parties should be maintained while anchored or at dock
  - e. Unattended Juniors are NOT permitted on the property
5. Contractors and vendors will be permitted on grounds, however:
- a. They must schedule their visits with strict approval of House or Waterfront Committee chairs
  - b. Make good faith effort to schedule work during off-peak times
  - c. Arrive with a minimum work force to complete project
  - d. Follow above stated safety rules regarding masks and social distancing
